ABOUT US

Ballet Pensacola is a non-profit 501(c)3 organization guided by the mission to “enhance the cultural life of the community through excellent dance training and quality dance performances.” For more than 35 years, the organization has promoted the personal and artistic growth of individuals, pride and cohesiveness among constituents, and a greater appreciation and support of dance from the community.

Ballet Pensacola offers classes for students age 3 through adult, beginner through professional. The primary focus of early training is to establish a love of dance while building a framework from which to learn. As students progress through our curriculum, the focus shifts to physical training where accuracy and consistency become foundational aspects of the curriculum.

REGISTRATION

To register for the 2018-19 sesason, complete and return the registration form (included in this brochure) to Ballet Pensacola with the registration fee (\$30 per student) and the first month's tuition. Class sizes are limited and early registration is recommended.

Ballet Pensacola's dance classes are open to all students meeting minimum age requirements. Ballet Pensacola accepts students without regard to sex, race, religion, national origin or disability. The organization reserves the right to cancel any classes not meeting minimum enrollment requirements. Students and families will be notified of canceled or rescheduled classes.

TUITION

Annual tuition is divided into ten equal payments, charged monthly (monthly tuition is the fee shown in this brochure). Tuition payments are due the first of each month. A \$20 late fee will be assessed to each payment received after the 10th of each month and for returned checks. Payments may be made by cash, check or credit card (MasterCard, Visa or Discover). Tuition may be automatically charged by credit card each month by request. Tuition and registration fees are non-refundable.

STUDENT PERFORMANCE OPPORTUNITIES

Performing Company

Fully registered students in the advanced Tech levels may audition for the Ballet Pensacola Performance Company. Company dancers may be asked to appear in performances and outreach events, including Fall Performances, *The Nutcracker*, Winter Performances and Spring Performances. Company activities are extracurricular to training schedules.

Youth Ensemble

Fully registered students in Tech 5 and above may audition for Ballet Pensacola's Youth Ensemble. Under the direction of Ballet Mistress Christine Duhon, the Youth Ensemble may have the opportunity to perform in Company productions as well as its own performances. The Youth Ensemble provides an excellent opportunity for Company-bound dancers to develop their technique and stagecraft prior to encountering the rigors of full Company responsibilities.

The Nutcracker

Fully registered, Training Division Ballet students, age 7 and older, may audition for *The Nutcracker*. A \$70 production fee is charged to all students appearing in *The Nutcracker*.

Student Showcase

Fully registered students in Tech 4 or below and those students registered in select Community Division classes may perform in the Ballet Pensacola Student Showcase. An \$80 production fee is charged to all students appearing in the Ballet Pensacola Student Showcase. For students appearing in multiple performances, a \$45 costume fee will be charged for each additional performance.

CHILDREN'S DIVISION

The Ballet Pensacola Children's Division teaches the fundamentals of dance in a fun environment. Designed for children ages 3-6, Children's Division students will develop skills in basic movement, coordination, memorization, artistic expression and teamwork. Each class features warm-ups, barre training, across-the-floor activities and concludes with an opportunity for "free dance expression." The Ballet Pensacola Academy is guided by a syllabus which provides monthly focus areas and milestones. The syllabus also ensures that Children's Division students will move seamlessly into the Training Division at age 7. Students attend Creative Dance or Pre-Ballet once per week and are placed by their age as of September 1, 2018. Please note that students who enroll in Tap/Jazz class must also be enrolled in Creative Dance or Pre-Ballet.

TRAINING DIVISION

The Ballet Pensacola Training Division provides formal dance training for students beginning at age 7. The Training Division is syllabus-driven, taking students through a graduated system of study that encompasses classical ballet, contemporary movement, and jazz technique. Each new level of training demands further commitment and physicality from the students. Training Division classes are led by Ballet Mistress Christine Duhon and are taught by the highly qualified faculty of Ballet Pensacola. Students must be age 7 by September 1, 2018, to enter Tech 1. Older students with prior experience will take an evaluation class to determine appropriate class placement.

Have multiple dancers in your family? The second sibling is given a \$50 annual discount on tuition (\$5) per month.

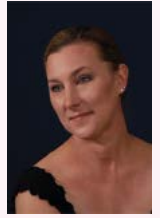

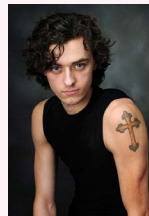

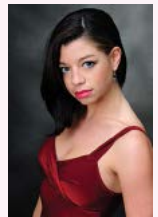
